The Fountain City Brass Band is committed to providing various educational programs and initiatives designed for our youth. The band's accessibility, affordability, and active performers/

teachers, position the FCBB extremely well to make an important contribution to education and to provide opportunities for exposure to professionals in the field.

In addition to concert programs, the Fountain City Brass Band offers several Educational Programs. Programs can be geared from the beginning instrumentalist to the college level.

The FCBB offers the following educational events and groups for your students:

The Fountain City Brass Quintet

The FCBQ is comprised of two trumpets, French horn, trombone/euphonium, and tuba. Programs are available for elementary, middle, high school, or college levels. The

FCBQ was a finalist at the 2001 Fischhoff National Music Competition.

The Twisted Steel Quartet

Twisted Steel is made up of two euphoniums and two tubas and offers the same variety of programming as the brass quintet. Twisted Steel was the winner of the 2000 International Tuba & Euphonium Conference Quartet Competition and has performed throughout North America and Europe.

Percussion Ensemble

The percussion ensemble consists of four players performing much in the same fashion as Twisted Steel and the FCBQ.

Conducting

Any performer/conductor may be available for rehearsing/teaching your ensemble.

Master Classes

A Master Class is designed for one of our performers to listen to your students play a prepared work, while the FCBB teacher makes comments.

Many of the FCBB musicians are currently or have been professional teachers at elementary, middle school, high school, and college levels. They can offer their ideas on rehearsal techniques, tuning, repertoire,

Seminars for Teachers

These sessions are geared towards the instrumental or studio teachers whom would like to hear different approaches to all levels of instrumental pedagogy.

Pre-Concert Lectures

Pre-Concert Lectures are available from musicians from the band as well as noted brass band historians. They can encompass the historical significance of the brass bands in America to detailed insight into the evenings' performance.

Clinics

Any number of combination of instruments can give any type of clinic. These work well for all age groups.
